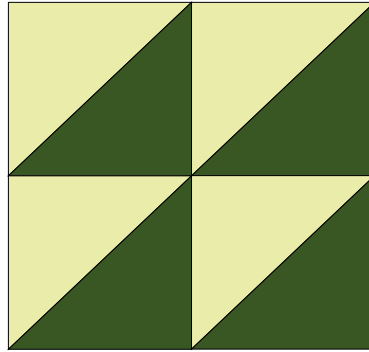






Greenmarket Square - PART 10

Doves in the Window (Variation) Block




Summary Cutting Chart for (4) Blocks

 Dark: (8) 5" x 5" squares

 Light: (8) 5" x 5" squares

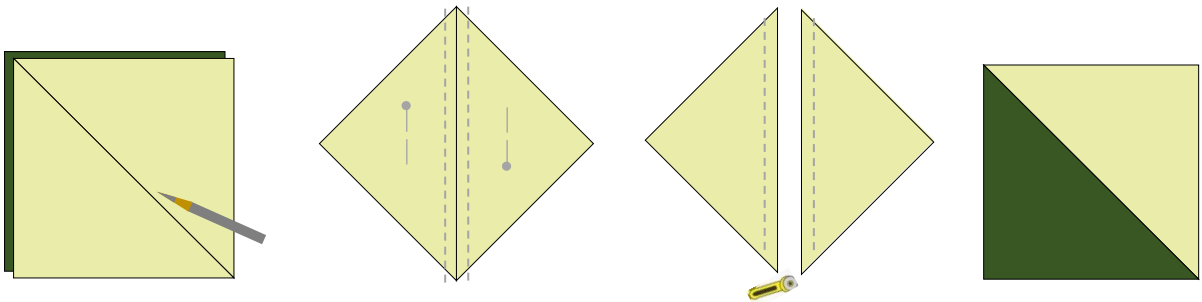
For (1) Blocks:

 (2) 5" x 5"

 (2) 5" x 5"

MAKE (16) Half Square Triangles (HST) – “Two at a Time” Method

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light fabric.
2. Pair a dark fabric with a light fabric, right sides together.
3. Iron the two fabrics together to bond them temporarily, making handling a lot easier. I also recommend pinning to hold the fabrics aligned.



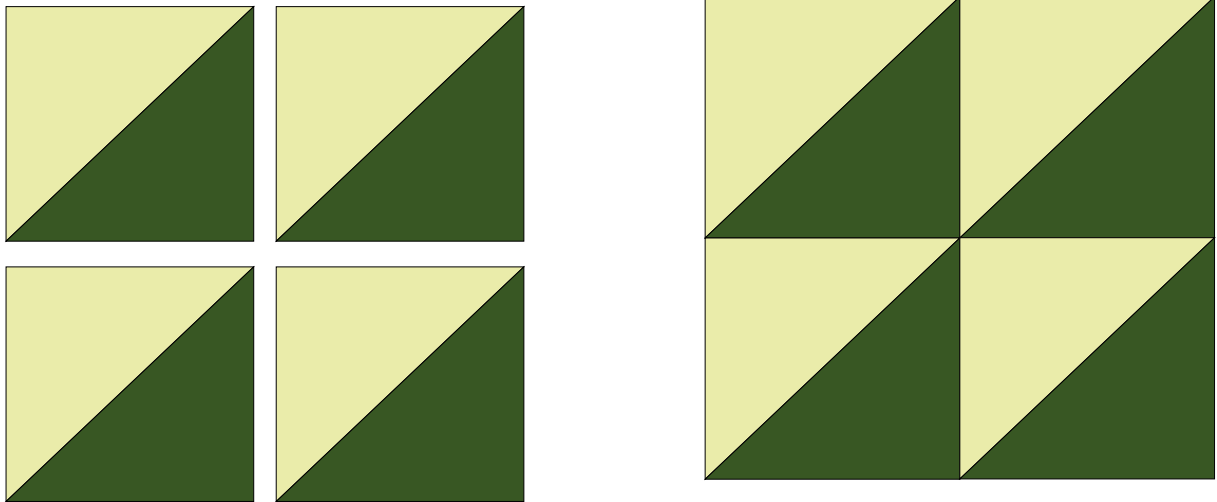
4. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the drawn line. Use chain-piecing (feeding one unit after another without cutting the joining threads) to speed up the process.

5. Before cutting the HST units apart, “set the stitching” (press the sewn line of stitching so that the stitches settle into the fabric). It is a little quicker than pressing the individual HST. Cut units apart on the diagonal. Press seams open (or to the dark fabric).

6. Trim to 4½” x 4½” square. Make sure the 45° diagonal line on the ruler is directly on top of the diagonal line in the block.

ASSEMBLE (4) Doves in the Window Blocks

1. Layout (4) blocks as shown. With right sides together, sew using ¼” seam allowance. Pin if required. Press seams open.
