The Cape Winelands Quilt



Brick floors are a fantastic choice for wine cellars due to their functional benefits and rustic aesthetic appeal. Whether you want a classic, elegant design or a more casual, earthy look, brick offers the versatility and charm that make it ideal for a wine storage space.

Make (4) Cellar Floor Blocks

OPTION 1: Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP)


Fabric Requirements:



Dark/Fabric 4
(4) 2¼" x 5¼" rectangles
(4) 2¼" x 6¾" rectangles



Medium/Fabric 3
(4) 2¼" x 3¾" rectangles
(4) 2¼" x 5¼" rectangles



Light/Fabric 2
(4) 2¼" x 2¼" squares
(4) 2¼" x 3¾" rectangles




Background/Fabric 1
(4) 2¼" x 2¼" squares

I recommend using FPP to make these blocks. The paper gives support when making these blocks and minimizes distortion when assembling the quilt top.

Please refer to the FPP instructions provided in Part 3.

1. Prepare (4) Cellar Floor FPP pattern units.

2. Precut all the fabric and do chain piecing to speed up the process. Follow the **FPP instructions provided in Part 3** to make (4) Cellar Floor Blocks.



3. Press the block and trim to $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$.

OPTION 2: Standard Piecing


Fabric Requirements:



Dark/Fabric 4
(4) 2" x 5" rectangles
(4) 2" x 6½" rectangles



Medium/Fabric 3
(4) 2" x 3½" rectangles
(4) 2" x 5" rectangles








Light/Fabric 2
(4) 2" x 2" squares
(4) 2" x 3½" rectangles




Background/Fabric 1
(4) 2" x 2" squares

1. Precut the fabric and chain piece to make (4) Cellar Floor blocks.
2. Set seams after stitching and press to the darker before sewing the next strip. This will ensure neatly completed log cabin blocks.

9. Press blocks and trim to $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$.
